Christmas in Russia

What you need


- Christmas fabric cut into strips or squares
- Small Styrofoam ball
- 15 cm of ribbon
- Straight pins

What to do





- 1. Cut the fabric into strips or squares to fit around the ball.
- Place one piece of fabric on the ball and push a pin all the way into the foam ball to hold the fabric.
- Choose another piece of fabric and slightly overlap with the piece that is already on the ball; use a few pins to hold the fabric in place.



- 4. Continue until the ball is completely covered.
- 5. When the ball is covered with fabric, loop the ribbon and use a pin to attach it to the top of the ball.



6. Hang it up and enjoy!
