Read *Clifford's Manners* to inspire your students to think more about their manners and how they affect other people. After reading the story, children can brainstorm a list of as many good manners as they can think of. Make it fun by encouraging role-playing or by using a Clifford puppet or stuffed animal to help bring your students' ideas to life.

Suggest that children choose a favourite manner each day and make a special effort to use it with everyone they interact with that day. Create a bulletin board of paper Cliffords (photocopy and enlarge the images below) with each student's favourite manner written on Clifford's bone.
