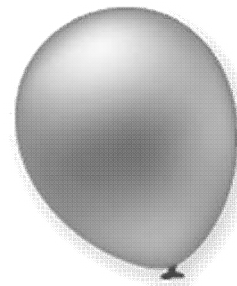

# Make a Boab Seed Rattle

Boab nuts are large nuts from the boab tree. It takes nine months for the seed inside to dry out. When it dries, it makes a rattling sound when shaken. Make your own seed rattle using a balloon.

## What you need

- Round balloon
- Large dried seed (bean) or a marble
- Permanent textas



## What to do

1. Push the seed or marble into the balloon.
2. Blow up the balloon until it is the size of a coconut. Be careful not to swallow the seed.
3. Tie off the balloon.
4. Decorate the outside of the balloon with Aboriginal art designs.
5. Shake or tap the balloon to make a rattling sound.
