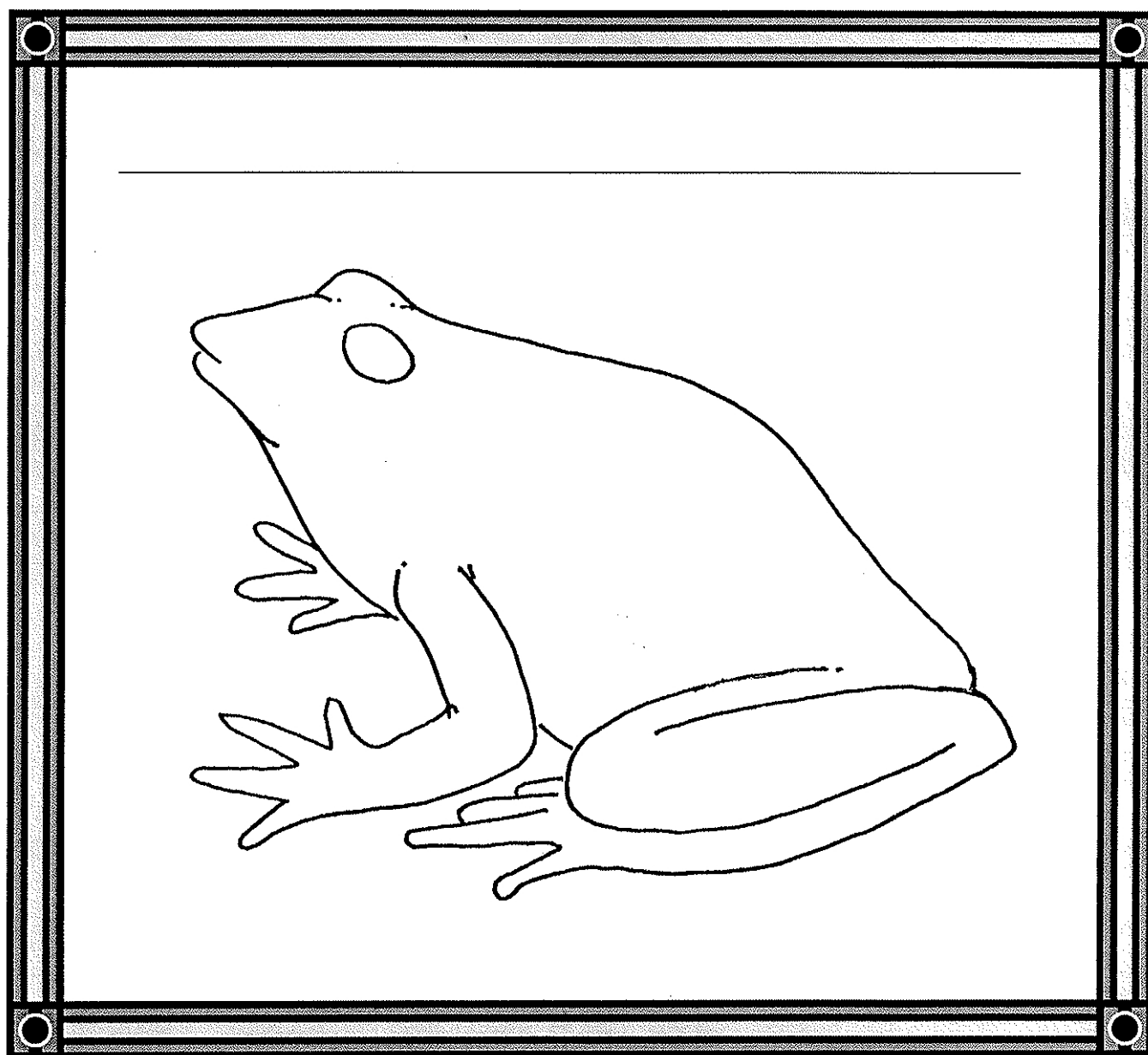


Make an Australian Frog Frieze!

Frog Outline

Provide each student with the name of one variety of Australian frog and a blank frog outline sheet (Australian Frogs list available from the Teacher Toolkit). Ask students to research their frogs on the internet, then colour and label their frog outlines accordingly. Instruct students to colour the border, according to their frog's conservation status. For example, extinct could be black, critically endangered could be red, endangered could be orange, and vulnerable could be yellow. Join these together to make a striking, informative frieze for display.



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
