## ACTIVITIES

- Colour the words of the poem with the appropriate colour.
- Ask the children to do the actions to the poem.
- Discuss the words in the poem that sound the same and introduce the word 'rhyming' to them.
- Give the children examples of rhyming words such as 'dog' and 'log'. Say a word and ask the children to give a word that rhymes with it.
- Discuss other actions that rhyme with the colour.
- Introduce a tune to the poem.
- Sing the poem and introduce the actions.
